## General Assistive Technology

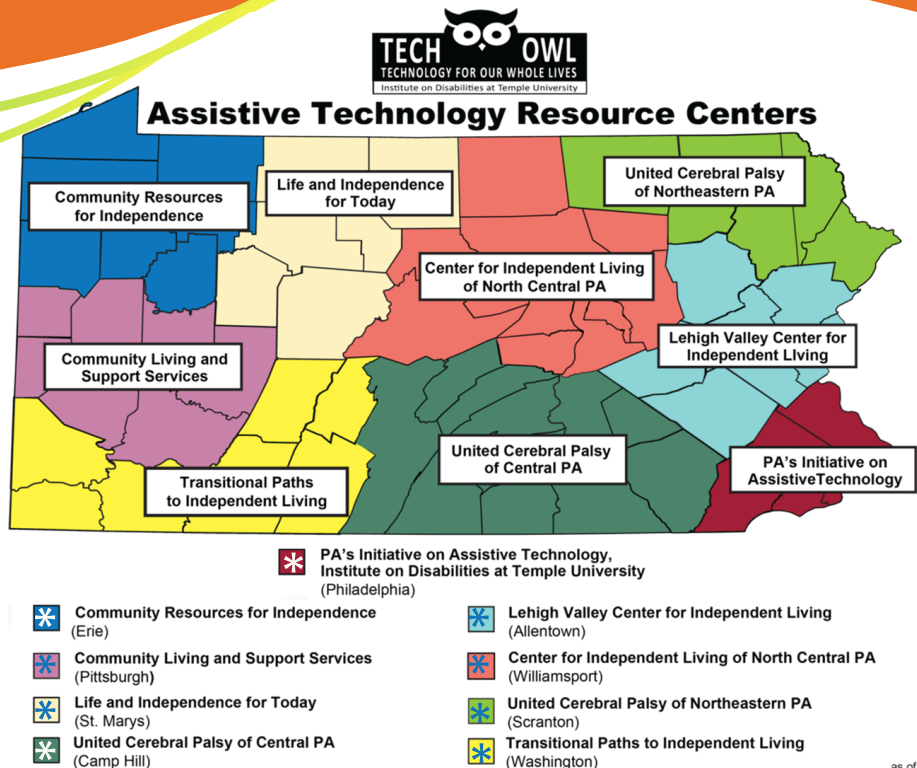
[Department of Human Services on Assistive Technology](#): Provides information on assistive devices and sources for funding.
