- To what extent will we use a disabilityinclusive approach to prepare for future emergencies?


The Arc of PA's Department of Health (DOH) Grant

- Held 4 quarterly meetings with 13 Regional Community Work Groups totaling over 272 members – representing 36 counties
- Held 4 quarterly meeting with a Statewide Task Force totaling 32 members - representing 22 organizations, agencies, and health care related companies
- Launched 4 English and Spanish radio ads
- Launched COVID-19 e-Learning Module
- Presented to multiple outside groups and agencies
- Selected as a CDC Novel Emerging Practice Evaluation Project







WHAT ARE SOME BENEFITS OF SPECIAL EDUCATION PROVIDED IN GENERAL EDUCATION CLASSROOMS?


Students with disabilities in inclusive classrooms:

Customized Employment matches the individual's skills, interests, and talents with the needs of a business.
